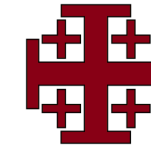

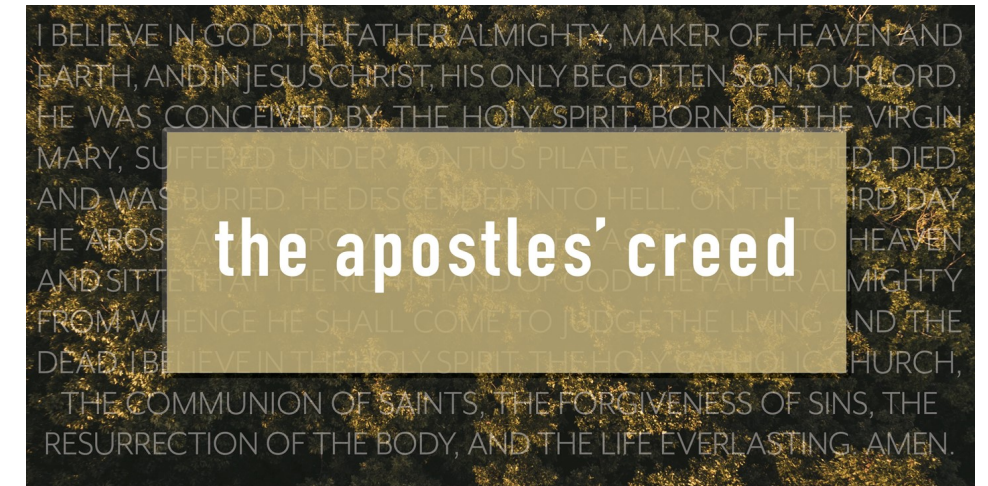

The Basics: The Creed

AS WE GATHER

There is great power in words and greater power when those words are spoken with others of the same mind and confession. For many centuries the people of God have used the words of the Apostles’ Creed to speak of what they believe. In the Creed we confess the faith we have received and assert that it is a summary of our belief. Through the Creed we rehearse and confirm the faith that is ours while we praise God for what He is and for what He has done for us.

Old Testament: Isaiah 6:1-4 (*The vision of Isaiah in the temple*)

Epistle: Romans 8:14-17 (We are heirs of God)

Gospel: Matthew 28:16-20 (*The Great Commission*)

Sermon: "All Authority, All Love" Matthew 28:16-20

¹⁶Now the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had directed them. ¹⁷And when they saw him they worshiped him, but some doubted. ¹⁸And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. ¹⁹Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

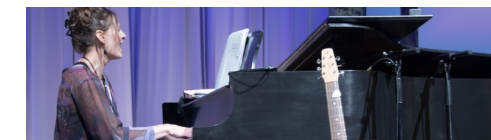
