These mats are lightweight, easy to clean, and provide insulation and a barrier between the individual and the ground or floor. We ask that you donate your unwanted plastic grocery bags to the receptacle in the Narthex labeled Plastic Bags. Please flatten them out to make them easier to transport, and to cut.
