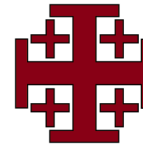

**Easter cards** are available in the Fellowship Hall for just \$1. If you want to buy a box of cards, they are \$5, just contact Susan Thomas.

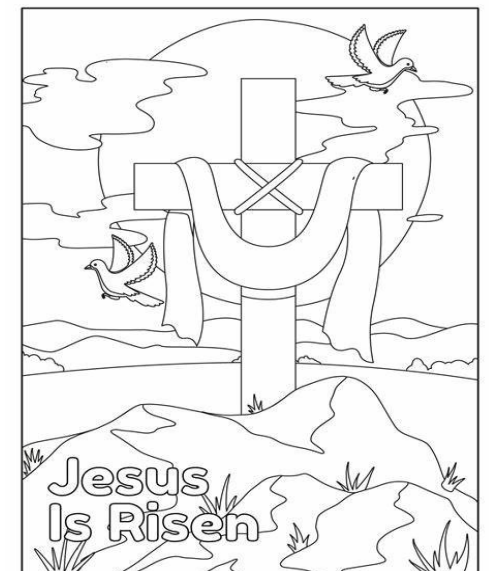
