



The Free Food Box Giveaway is the 3rd Saturday of the month. In February we had our first food box giveaway and served 9 families. In March we served 21 families. Thank you to those who are responsible for getting the word out by providing a sign and a stand for the sign.

Each family received a food box, and a prayer from Deacon Danner. Included in the food box is information designed to help them in their walk with Jesus or to bring them to Jesus. We look forward to the 3rd Saturday of the month and the opportunity to help others.
