Included in the food box is information designed to help them in their walk with Jesus or to bring them to Jesus. We look forward to the 3rd Saturday of the month and the opportunity to help others. The grant from the Lutheran Thrift Shop helps to fill our food pantry, and your donations fill in the gap. Thank you for your donations to the food pantry and remember to shop at the West Valley Lutheran Thrift Shop on 107th and Peoria Ave. Volunteers are needed to process, cashier, or help as needed. It’s a pressure free job with great benefits – like making new friends!
We need your help! Households cannot use SNAP benefits to buy any nonfood items such as cleaning supplies, paper products, and other household supplies. Therefore, in addition to food, we want to help with: **deodorant, toilet paper, paper towels, shower gel, shaving gel, shampoo, soap, toothpaste (we have a lot of toothbrushes), feminine products, and baby supplies. Items must be unopened.** We make available these types of items when they pick up their box if they need them.
