
Our kiddos are gearing up for kindergarten, some are excited to go, some want to stay with Miss Kellie and Miss Susan, but we will have them ready by the end of June.



Michelle Zollinger, LWML Louisiana-Mississippi District President was honored and thrilled to be able to present the mission grant funding payment for MG#12 Sharing Christ Crucified with High School Youth — Lutheran High School (LHS) of Greater New Orleans, Louisiana.

LHS, the only high school in the LCMS Southern District, has been serving youth for over 50 years. It provides students with the opportunity to academically succeed in a safe environment, while educating them about their Lord and Savior through the teachings of the LCMS. Many of the students being served by the school are disadvantaged, culturally diverse, and unchurched. These grant funds will be matched by five generous donors and will be used to pay the tuition costs of ten students.

Michelle Zollinger and Gladys Brown, New Orleans Zone President, were present on February 27, 2024, when Religion Teacher Rev. Nare, students, and faculty opened the weekly Tuesday morning LHS Chapel Service held in adjacent First English Lutheran Church, in the name of our Triune God. The student choir and guitarist led two praise songs. Following the conclusion of the Chapel Service, the final payment check for Mission Grant #12 was joyfully presented and received.
